



































"YOU GOT ANY THOUGHTS SIR?.... THERES ALMOST

TOO MUCH







A local architect, Paul Maich, was found dead yesterday in the house which was going to be passed over to the client that same day. Police have said in a statement this morning that the death is suspicious and they are treating the case as a murder investigation. The location of the murder is in the small Fife village of East Wemyss, where Paul had recently completed his first project, titled, "The Cognitive Dwelling". It seems to be at this point unclear who the actual client is. The first investigation seems to have uncovered that in Maich's notes there are five clients, yet they are not referred to by real names, but alias' which may have been created by the designer himself; the Insomniae, the Inventor, the Miner, the Amnesiae and the Recluse. At this early stage police are trying to locate these five people, whether as suspects or possible witness' is unclear.

The body was found in the early hours yesterday by a neighbour, who saw Maich arrive but not leave. It appears the architect was found on the upper level of the building, the library. The neighbour, who cannot be named at this point, said in a statement; 'I had heard a commotion in the early hours of the morning, and a car leaving the house, driving too fast. In the morning paul's car was still there. I desided to go over to the house and see if everything was ok. With no answer at the door, I went inside; I was curious to see what the house was like. I shouted to see if anybody was there, but there was no answer. I walked around the ground floor; feeling completely lost, but eventually found a stair up to the next floor. Even during the day the lower floors seemed very dark, the light lost in the high spaces; I couldn't find any light writches. The house has now been scaled off, and a murder investiga-tion is underway; Police hope to find crucial evidence. We have been informed that extra officers have been called to the scene due to the labyrinthine nature of the building. It seems that there are many hidden passages concealed in the walls. A fine of death has been established but the cause has not been released. The neighbour commented simply "The body was lying on the floor and not moving, I could see blood, I phoned the police immediately.

Locals have commented that the whole project has been shrouded in controversy and secrecy. No one in the immediate area had even been informed of the recent sale of the mine area, or of the house to be built at the end of the street. Yet it has become apparent that Maich is actually from this street. He lived in number 4 Randolph Street until eighteen years old.

In the early evening the police released a statement; Detective Inspector Dougle Milton said; "I can certify that the victim is Paul Maich, he was found this morning, and we are treating his death as murder. We have several suspects and are appealing to any of the local people if you seen or heard anything to come forward. We also urge anyone who knows these five people, if you know about their whereabouts, come forward. Thank you."

Maich had deliberately kept the building under a shroud of secrecy, it was never supposed to be revealed. The once empty, anonymous building is now swarming with police and forensic teams. Open for everyone to observe, unveiled and exposed.
























- A- Exhibit A; photograph of footprint in blood
